LARGERSTROMIA INDICA 'CREPE MYRTLE'



Origin: China, Korea and Japan

Habit: Rounded with upright branching. Multi-stemmed.

Description: Glossy, leathery, medium green leaves turn reddish-orange to dark red in Autumn. Young growth tinged red.

Tolerances: Adaptable to a range of conditions, heat and some dryness but requires adequate moisture during establishment. Moderate resistance to powdery mildew.

Notes: Best in moist, well drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun. Transplants easily provided adequate moisture levels are maintained. Bare rooted Indian Summer® *Lagerstroemia* should be pruned back by 30% when planted – this will help promote spring growth by allowing the plant to first
