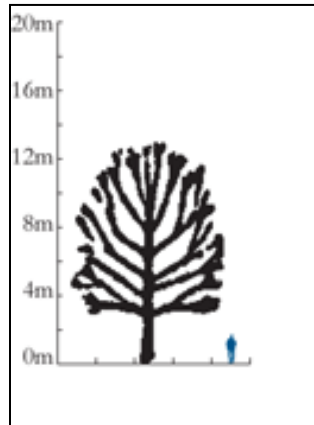

Origin: Variety

Habit: Medium to large fast growing deciduous tree. Domed to broadly conical habit, the dimensions attained range between 10-15m high x 8-10m wide.

Description: Dense, lustrous foliage turns deep bronze in Autumn. Attractive grey bark. A seedless variety. large shade tree generally maturing at 40' tall by 25' wide, becoming rounded or sometimes irregular in growth habit with age, without a central leader rapid growth rate.

Tolerances: Adapts to most soils. High tolerance to drought, waterlogging, and wind. Moderate frost and pollution tolerance. Full sun to partial sun prefers moist, well-drained soils in full sun, but is very adaptable to poor soils, rocky soils, compacted soils, wet sites, dry sites, pollution, and Winter salt spray (extremely urban tolerant)

Notes: Requires formative prune to develop strong structure.
