Habit:

Eucalyptus robusta Matong (PBR) is a new form of Eucalyptus bred for its reduced size and consistent shape. Ideal for use as a street tree or a feature in parks and gardens. Juvenile foliage starts out bronze turning to dark green on maturity. Grows to approx. 15m H x 7m W.

Description: Eucalyptus robusta 'Matong', commonly known as the Swamp Mahogany, stands tall in the world of eucalyptus with its robust nature and unmistakable presence. Native to coastal eastern Australia, this tree is well-regarded for its adaptability to various soil types, especially swampy soils. With broad, dark green leaves and white blossoms, it offers a serene, yet invigorating experience to any landscape..

Tolerances: Full sun wet and swampy soil.
